Be Prepared—Reminders for Camp!

Second Grade Camp is located at the Fairfield School on Beach Street. There will be signs with instructions for the health screening and camp check-in. There will be staff inside and outside to guide your child to the correct locations.

The Saco School Department is providing FREE breakfast (8:00am-9:00am) and lunch (11:30am-12:30pm) daily for those interested. Please have your child bring a change of clothes in a gallon bag that will stay at camp, water bottle (we will also provide a water bottle), sunscreen if you prefer a specific kind (we will have sunscreen on camp) and if bringing a lunch please use a disposable bag (paper or plastic). We will be providing a basket for each camper to store their items, and are asking that campers do not bring a backpack this year. Campers will receive their camp shirt, water bottle, and facial covering from us on their first day of camp.
