**Auditions:** auditions take place during the first couple of weeks of rehearsals. Students do not need to prepare songs in advance; all audition material will come from the show and there will be workshops to learn songs. Participants will know their parts within the first few weeks of the session.

**Performance Needs:**

- **Performance Day Apparel Needs:** For performances, we ask students to please wear black shorts (like bike shorts) and a solid color tank top that will remain on underneath costumes. They will need black or dark shoes (jazz shoes, dance shoes, sneakers, dress shoes, please **NO** open-toed shoes), and **CAMP SHIRTS!** (Camp shirts will be distributed in the fall if your child didn't receive them already at a prior summer production).
- Any special additional costume information about your child's character will be provided during the fall.
- Snacks - extra snacks on show day!
- We recommend everything be labeled with your child's name
